- Application must be signed
- Submit with your application the most recent transcript containing overall grade point average.
- The applicant shall prepare an original statement of 500 words or less setting forth his/her vocational or professional goal and relating how past, present, and future activities make accomplishment of this goal possible.
- Applicant must be prepared to provide a recent photo if selected.

**Applications must be received no later than 5:00pm April 8, 2011. Postmarks do not count.**
